- *For those who will be taking a course held on CSU's campus, Monday through Friday, between 7am and 5pm, you will need a CSU guest parking permit. We will mail these permits to you with your course confirmation. Be sure to follow all directions as to how to use/place the permit.*
- *In a rare circumstance, a location may change. Should this occur, you will be contacted prior to the class session. This is **why we have asked for your e-mail address and your phone number. We hope you included that information as you registered.***
- *Not knowing starting point for all those needing directions, we have opted to anchor each set of directions at a specified major intersection.*
- *For first class session, we will have Osher signs at the building's main entrance, indicating the direction of the classroom.*

Southwest corner of College and W. Pitkin Street. Parking is on the west side of the building.

From College Avenue, turn west on Mountain Avenue.

Colorado Welcome Center (Also Environmental Learning Center)

(A bit West of the I-25 Interchange)

Beginning at the intersection of College Avenue and Prospect - Go EAST on Prospect, through stop lights at Lemay, Timberline, and Summit View. You will pass a fair amount of open space on your RIGHT/SOUTH side. As you get close to I-25, you will see two stop lights ahead (going up a hill). Before you reach either of those lights, you will see a brown sign on your RIGHT saying "Colorado Welcome Center." Turn into the drive just past that sign. As you curve along the road to the SOUTH, you will see a modern building on your RIGHT. Keep going and take the turn into the parking lot which is just to the SOUTH side of the building. You will see a green sign that says "Welcome to Fort Collins: Home of CSU." The classroom is at the far NORTH end of the building.

Community Foundation of Northern Colorado

4745 Wheaton Drive, Suite 100

From Lemay and Harmony, GO EAST on Harmony for .2 miles until you get to Wheaton. TURN RIGHT/SOUTH at the first (right hand) turn lane you come to past Lemay – this turn takes you onto Wheaton). Go one block; go through stop sign, then turn RIGHT/WEST into first driveway you come to. You have just turned into a big parking lot used for a number of buildings. Once you enter parking lot, turn right as soon as you can; go a bit to the North. You will see the Community Foundation Building on your right (it is first building you come to).

1st Bank – Conference Room

2644 South Timberline

Beginning at Timberline and Drake - Go SOUTH on Timberline until you get to the first stop light south of Drake. Get into the LEFT turn lane; as you do so, you will notice the 1st Bank on your LEFT/EAST. It is a flat, brown brick building. Turn LEFT/EAST at Custer Avenue (at the stop light). Take the next LEFT onto Illinois. Go to stop sign, turn LEFT, and go straight through King Soopers' Parking Lot to get to the bank. Conference room is in the NORTHEAST corner of the bank.

Near the intersection of East Harmony Road and Corbett Drive.

Gifford Building – various rooms

Colorado State University Campus

Beginning at College and Prospect - Go WEST on Prospect to first stop light –Turn RIGHT/NORTH at Centre Avenue. Go ½ block to the driveway on your RIGHT and turn into the parking lot. You are about ¾ of a block away from Gifford. After parking – walk NORTH to the intersection of Centre and Lake; cross to the NORTH side of the street. Walk LEFT/WEST. You will pass one building on your right; keep going to the SECOND building (3 –story, poured concrete with some brick trim). The sign identifying it as the Gifford Building is about waist high, to the left of the sidewalk (may be somewhat hidden by garden plants.) At the walkway, turn RIGHT/NORTH into the Building. (You may also be fortunate enough to find parking on Lake Street a bit closer to the building).

Lyric Cinema Café

300 East Mountain Avenue

Beginning at College and Mountain - The Lyric is on the NORTHEAST corner of Mountain and Walnut/Mathews. Go EAST on Mountain. At one block (Remington), you will note the public “pay” parking garage on your right (Southeast corner of Mountain and Remington. If you are a bit more adventurous, get off on a side street to the south and look for parking on the street. Please be sure to note the parking signs that often give a parking limit of two hours. (Your best bet really is the Parking Garage or you may be in for a bit of a walk as you go a few blocks to the south to find street parking without time limitations.)

MOBY PARKING LOT

Colorado State University Campus

(Northeast of Elizabeth and Shields)

Beginning at Elizabeth and Shields - _ At the stop light at the intersection of Elizabeth and Shields go EAST (on Elizabeth) into the parking lot by Moby Gym and the McGraw Athletic Building. Go EAST into the parking lot and then go to the LEFT/ NORTHEAST corner of that lot.

- For bus field trips, you will meet the CSU bus in the Northeast Corner of the Moby Lot.

Be sure to park in the EASTERN-most rows labeled for “A” parking permits. Note: We will mail you the parking permits with your course registration. (Do NOT go into the parking lot closer to Laurel Street, that is for students only and you will likely be ticketed).

Go SOUTH on Lemay and go THROUGH the light at Harmony. Take the first RIGHT/WEST turn into a driveway. You will pass an island with a mailbox in it. At the end of the island, turn LEFT/SOUTH; then turn RIGHT/ WEST as soon as you can. (A big parking lot is now on your right side). The store is on the SOUTH side of that parking lot which is shared by Ace Hardware, Half Moon Bay Coffee Company, Fiona's Deli and more.
